Yesterday evening a distressed mum came into school to inform us that her child had not made it home from school. This was sometime after the end of school. Despite her best efforts and those of school staff the child could not be found. We phoned the police who responded very quickly and shortly after the child was found, none the wiser for all the worry they had caused. Clearly this was an awful experience for all concerned and a parent's worst nightmare. It serves to remind us all of the importance of talking to our children about how they can keep themselves safe. It also highlights how we as a school have to inform the police if a child is reported missing.

Safer Internet Day - On Tuesday, 7th February it will be 'Safer Internet Day'. Safer Internet Day aims to raise awareness of safety online. The theme this year is 'Be the change: unite for a better internet'. To launch the day in school our E safety Crew will be leading a whole school assembly on Monday. On Tuesday and throughout the week children will spend time in lessons learning about their role online and how they can help create a safer internet. Please take the time to discuss internet safety with your child and if you have any concerns, please come and talk to us.
