- Ensure the school has the correct contact details for my child.
- Read communications (letters, newsletters) from school.
- Attend parent / teacher evenings.
- Not take holidays in school time

- Ensure every child feels safe, happy and healthy in school.
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum to meet the needs of each child.
- Explain our school rules and encourage each child to follow them.
- Reward and encourage a positive attitude towards lifelong learning

- Keep parents / guardians informed of their child's progress.
- Ensure homework tasks are explained clearly and given on a consistent basis.

- Have high expectations for each child that can succeed and do well.
- Follow Local Authority safeguarding procedures for schools.
- Consult with parents / guardians on aspects of school life.
