## Long Lawford News...

Welcome back to all our families and a very special welcome to the children and families who have joined Long Lawford for the first time this week. It has been good to see the children looking smart in their school uniforms and ready to learn. This week in my assemblies I have reflected on the Rio Olympics with the children and the amazing Great Britain team. I have also talked about some of the amazing Paralympians and their 'yes I can' attitude. I am hoping the children can all have a 'yes I can' attitude this year with their learning.

**Important reminders** - At the start of a new school year I will like to draw parents and carers attention to the following:

**Allergies** - We have a number of children in school with allergies, especially nuts, and I would ask parents and carers to avoid bringing nuts and nut products into school.

**Punctuality** - To avoid disruptions to learning it is important that children are on time for school everyday. Children are asked to arrive at school from 8:40am onwards (when the doors are open). Doors will close at 8:55am and after this time children must report to the main school office.

**Bikes and scooters** - Children and adults should not use their bike or scooter anywhere on the school site. Children and adults should walk with their bikes and scooters at all times whilst on the school grounds.

**Before school** - If your child makes their own way to school please remind them that they should come straight to school. In the interests of safety I am keen to avoid children going to the skate park or shop on route and when they should be at school.

**Dinner monies** - Please note that school dinners for children in the juniors (Years 3 to 6) now cost £2.10 per day or £10.50 per week. All meals must be paid for in advance and we would prefer that this is done on a Monday please.

**School uniform** - The vast majority of children wear the correct uniform each day and look very smart. Unfortunately, we have had a few children coming to school dressed inappropriately—with hoodies and/or trainers. I would ask parents and carers to ensure that their child is properly dressed each day.

**Data collection** - Parents and carers will shortly be receiving a contact information sheet. Please return this form to school with any updated information e.g. change of address, doctors, mobile numbers etc. It is also really important that the school is made aware of any medical conditions or allergies. The signed form should be returned even if there are no changes, just to confirm that our information is correct. Thank you.

**Asthma** - If your child has asthma you must let the school know and complete an asthma record card (available from the main school office). If your child already has an asthma card we will be sending a copy home so that it can be updated with any changes required.
