Hello and welcome to our final newsletter for this half term. Although a short Spring Term (only 10 teaching weeks in total!) it has felt like a very busy term.

I am very proud of the children and all they have achieved. We've loved celebrating Number Day in February and World Book Day in March (videos coming soon!)

I am happy to remind all of our families that we are supporting On-Side coaching (our wraparound provider) with Holiday and Food club bookings (also known as HAF). They will be providing both funded places (for families whose children are entitled to Pupil Premium funding) and paid places (for families that can pay for their child to attend the club). You can book via https://www.onsidecoaching.co.uk/east-warwickshire/home or you can get in touch with us and we will help you. The club will be held on site at Long Lawford Primary School.

Coming up next half term we have Year 6 SATs, and families were invited to a briefing this week. If you weren't able to attend, please get in touch with your child's class teacher and they will be happy to talk you through the information. All Year 6 children will be offered a **free** breakfast and can come into school from 8am Monday-Thursday of SATs week.

School Day Consultation

You may recall that in February, all stakeholders were sent a link to a consultation form regarding extending the school day by 15 minutes. We had a strong response to the consultation, with almost a third of our families responding - the highest response rate for a number of years.

The consultation feedback from all stakeholders (including families, staff and external providers) has now been reviewed and will be discussed at the next Full Governing Body Meeting (in April).

Formal feedback will be provided to all stakeholders after it has been discussed with the Full Governing Body - I anticipate that this will be towards the end of April or the beginning of May.

We are a **nut free school.**



Please be aware that we **cannot** have nuts in school in any form.

This also includes any hair products, skin products, lip balms etc. (This list is not exhaustive, so please check the packaging of products closely). The most common nuts used in general products (food or other) are almonds, Brazil nuts, cashews, hazelnuts, macadamias, peanuts, pecans, pistachios and walnuts (again, this list is not exhaustive).

We appreciate that this is an additional thing to check, and we know that you recognise the importance of it, however, I do have to insist that we are a **nut free school** to ensure the safety of those with significant and severe nut allergies. I know if this were your child, you would expect that we all help, especially as it is a life-threatening condition.



They are also running a book cover design competition.


















Martial Arts
